We will be holding an 'Open Art Exhibition' at the Albert Room – the former meeting room – in Cleethorpes Library in December 2018. Any artist is eligible to enter. Terms and Conditions

Artists can submit one or two pieces of 2D art each up to one meter by one meter in size. We regret that we cannot accept work larger than this or 3D art or video art etc on this occasion. The entry fee for submitting work to this open exhibition is £5 per artwork submitted and this will not be refunded if your work is not accepted into the exhibition itself. Your entry fee should be paid by cash or by cheque made payable to Lincs Inspire Limited at the front desk of Cleethorpes Library. Please tell the staff that your payment is for the Open Art Exhibition.

Initial submission is by email or photograph of artwork only. Artists are asked to email dave.power@lincsinspire.com a good quality photograph of each work they are submitting along with the completed form immediately below for each work they enter. Or, artists can post a copy of the photograph(s) to David Power, Arts Development Team, Bradley Football Development Centre, Bradley Road, Grimsby. DN37 0AG.

Selection for the exhibition will be made by a panel of two judges led by Rachel McWilliam. Each and every artwork submitted will be considered by these two judges and they will make the selections for the Open Exhibition. Their decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into on this matter. Artists must agree to this condition in order to be eligible to enter the Open Exhibition. The deadline for submission is midnight on Monday 19th November.

We will decide which works have been accepted for the exhibition by close of play on Friday 23rd November. You will then be notified of the judges' decision. If your work is accepted, you will be asked to bring it to the Albert Room at Cleethorpes Library on Thursday 29th November 2017 between 5pm and 7pm or Saturday 1st December between 10am and 12 noon. Your work should have mirror plates attached for ease of hanging. The exhibition runs from Tuesday 4th December to Saturday 12th January inclusive. Unsold work can be collected from the Albert Room on Tuesday 15th January from 9am to 5pm. Please bring some ID when you are collecting your work. If you are unable to collect your work that day, please contact us to make alternative arrangements.

There will be two cash prizes. One of £50 and one of £25. There will also be a public vote throughout the exhibition to determine the public's own favourite artwork

Payment for sold work will be sent to you by cheque made out to yourself and posted to the address you supplied. If you wish this done in a different manner, please contact us in good time so we can make alternative arrangements. There will be 20% commission charged on any work that is sold. This will be subtracted at source.
